MEN’S STICK & PUCK

Stick and Puck sessions are an opportunity for players 18 & older to get out on the ice to practice their skating and stick handling with a puck. These are non-competitive sessions and no scrimmaging allowed. Participants must have a helmet with a full face shield, gloves and stick. Rink provided pucks.

Tuesdays 9:00-10:00am Adults (18 & older) \$5.00

WOMEN’S STICK & PUCK

Stick and Puck sessions are an opportunity for players 18 & older to get out on the ice to practice their skating and stick handling with a puck. These are non-competitive sessions. Participants must have a helmet with a full face shield, gloves and stick. Rink provided pucks.

Thursdays 9:00-10:00am Adults (18 & older) \$5.00

FREESTYLE SKATING

Freestyle Figure Skating is an open time for figure skaters to practice jumps, spins and moves in the field. This time is reserved for figure skaters only.

Tuesdays and Thursdays 11:00am-Noon \$15.00

FAMILY STICK AND PUCK

Designed for adults to accompany their children/youth in a non-contact environment. Participants 18 and younger require full equipment and an adult must be on the ice with them. Adults must wear skates, a helmet, and gloves. Make sure to bring your own stick and puck!

SKATING LESSONS

All classes will meet once a week, with classes 35 minutes long. This longer class time gives the student more ice time to LEARN-TO-SKATE. Classes are offered on Thursday. Emphasis is on basic skills for the recreational as well as the serious skater. No double runners are allowed for lessons.

Session 1 - \$58 – Five weeks - **Registration for Session 1 begins October 8

Session 2 - \$70 – Six weeks – **Registration for Session 2 begins December 1

*FREE SKATE RENTALS FOR LESSONS

Reservations are required for those who need skates. Size quantities are limited.

*FREE SKATING

Students enrolled in lessons will be given up to SIX FREE public skating sessions.

*FREE PRACTICE TIME

CLASS MAKE-UP POLICY Classes cancelled by the Recreation Department due to inclement weather will be made up the week following the last class in a session.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

PRE-STAR (4-5 years)

Class provides ice acclimation and an introduction to skating skills with an emphasis on fun and safe recreational skating. This program is for mobile skaters with some level of skating ability.

SKATERS MUST BE ABLE TO STAND AND GET UP ON THE ICE WITHOUT ASSISTANCE.

Helmets are required.

1 STAR

FOR A CHILD WHO HAS PASSED PRE-STAR LEVEL OR HAS SOME SKATING EXPERIENCE.

Course includes: March and glide across rink; fall down and get up properly; back wiggle; 2 foot glides and dip; intro to forward swizzles, snowplow scrape.

SKATERS MUST BE ABLE TO STAND AND GET UP ON THE ICE WITHOUT ASSISTANCE.

2 STAR

FOR THOSE WHO HAVE PASSED 1 STAR OR HAVE TAKEN, BUT NOT PASSED 2 STAR.

Course includes: Forward swizzles across rink; snowplow stop, 1-foot glide on left & right foot, back swizzles.

3 STAR

FOR THOSE WHO HAVE PASSED 2 STAR OR HAVE TAKEN, BUT NOT PASSED 3 STAR.

Course includes: Forward stroking; forward pumps on circle, One foot glide on circle both directions; back swizzles across rink; T push; T stop; forward lunge; 2 foot turn forward to backward; hockey stop.
